A chemical change is any change that results in the formation of new chemical substances. At the molecular level, chemical change involves making or breaking of bonds between atoms. These changes are chemical: Ex. iron rusting (iron oxide forms) A physical change is any change NOT involving a change in the substance's chemical identity.
